- 4. General Grant Scheme Budget Statement: To note the budget statement dated 4 November 2019.
- 5. General Grant Applications: To consider the following applications and make recommendations to Council:
  - a) Burton Out of School Club: £250 towards the cost of coach travel for the children's Summer Trip.
  - b) Shepley & District Naturalists' Society: £200 to help with running costs.
  - c) Kirkburton Senior Citizens Support Group: £250 to contribute towards the cost of the Annual Tea.
  - d) **Farnley Tyas Community Group**: £250 to contribute towards the costs of website hosting, room hire, plants for the village community tubs.

  - i) Shelley Brownies: £500 to purchase new program resources for the Brownie Unit.
  - j) Shepley Band: £250 to update the website, provide promotional materials and advertising for the band.
  - k) Shepley Bird & Wildlife Group: £250 to assist with running costs.
  - 1) **Yetton Together**: £5,000 to contribute to repair drystone walls and styles by the cricket field. The application was deferred pending receipt of further information in November 2018.
  - m) Grange Moor Youth Training Band: £1,957 to contribute towards the cost of purchasing new instruments, equipment and a gazebo.
  - n) Lepton Highlanders Sports & Social Club: £2,613 to contribute towards the installation of 3 double gates to safeguard the entrance to the playing / grass facilities.
  - o) Flockton Forward: £804 towards the cost of purchasing and installing a defibrillator at the Sun Inn.
