MINUTES OF THE MEETING ON 16th AUGUST 2012 at 7.30 pm AT BURTON VILLAGE HALL

Officer in attendance: Mrs A Royle Apologies were received from Cllr K Dunn. Cllr Munro apologised for lateness. **MF14 Apologies and Declarations of** Cllr Parsley declared a personal interest in Shelley Village Hall, as she is a resident of Shelley Interest and therefore a member of Shelley Community Association. There were no members of the public present. **MF15** Public **Participation** Resolved: To hold the meeting in the public session except for the item concerning the sale of **MF16** Admission of the Shelley Village Hall (Min MF17), as it concerned ongoing negotiations. Public Cllr A Munro entered the meeting during the following item. **Shelley Village MF17** Hall The Committee considered the advice received from the Council's solicitor on the Sale Agreement Committee's previous recommendations. Recommendation: That the Council accepts the proposed changes to the Sale Agreement as detailed in Appendix 2. Members noted the YLCA advice regarding the future process needed to conclude the sale of Shelley Village Hall. **Recommendation:** That the Clerk uses delegated authority to inform Shelley Community Association directly of the Committee's recommended amendments in order to expedite a prompt conclusion of the negotiations. The Clerk was asked to inform the Council's solicitor of the Committee's recommendations and request that he conveys them to the SCA's solicitor as soon as possible. **Recommendation**: That the Clerk instructs the Solicitor to prepare the final document for signature when appropriate. Members noted the latest Finance Statement as at 9th August 2012. The Clerk indicated that **MF18** 2012-13 Accounts there were two items which were likely to exceed the budget and recommended that the Committee reconsiders the matter at the next meeting in November. Recommendation: That the Committee notes the information and reconsiders the matter at the next meeting in November. Members noted the Council's Aims & Objectives as produced in 2008 and discussed possible **MF19** Aims & amendments to update it with the current policy. **Objectives Recommendation**: That the following amendments are made: Health: To reword the Aim "To encourage access to open spaces and promote health and well being by providing allotments and developing appropriate projects, as well as supporting community amateur sports organisations."

Responsibility (k): To substitute the words "Council property" for "office equipment".
