Members considered the application for £2,175 from Lascelles Hall Cricket Club to cover the cost of submitting the current Clubhouse scheme design to Kirklees Planning Services and to apply for a change of use of the adjacent farmer's field to sports field.

Cricket Club**

Recommendation: That the Council awards £2,175 to Lascelles Hall Cricket Club to cover the above named costs.

Members considered the application for £5,000 towards the cost of installing a full height climbing wall and bouldering wall in the Sports Hall at the College to be available for full community use outside of school hours. It was also noted that Shelley College is actually situated in the Denby Dale Parish Council area but a large proportion of the students live within the Kirkburton Parish Council area.

Recommendation: That the Council awards £2,500 to Shelley College Fundraisers.

Recommendation: The Clerk to contact Shelley College Fundraisers to suggest they approach Denby Dale Parish Council for the rest of the money.

Members considered the application for £2,100 to contribute towards the cost of purchasing new musical instruments.
