Members considered the written report and photos of repairs needed to the wall immediately adjacent to the gate along Church Lane. The Clerk detailed the process required to make the repair including having a survey carried out, producing a specification, obtaining permission from Kirklees Conservation & Design and obtaining a Faculty from the Diocese of Wakefield. She further advised that the timing of the works was restricted to the period when there was a high chance of there being no frost, due to the probable need for lime mortar. Recommendation : That Lucas Lee is instructed to carry out a structural survey on the condition of the wall and to establish which sections are in need of repair, identifying which sections were in greatest need, advising on the urgency and providing options if appropriate.		
The Clerk reported that she had received complaints from residents that the trees to the rear of Rectory Drive in the lower section of the Churchyard were getting too high and were seriously impacting on their gardens. She further reported that the Church had also been advised of the problems.	К5	Other works
It was agreed that the Clerk would use delegated authority to obtain professional advice from a tree surgeon on the trees and the urgency of the work, which would be subject to permission due to the Tree Preservation Orders.
