The submission from the Friends of Lepton Library was discussed. **Friends of Lepton** 

**Recommendation**: To award a grant of £1,240 in 2016/17 to fund bookdrops operated in the village. Also to request the Clerk to inform the applicants that their application for future funding should be made in the year to which the grant would apply.

Cllr Beresford and Cllr McGuin rejoined the meeting.

Cllr Armer reported that the grant the Parish Council had applied for from the Rural District **MF23 Hanging Baskets** Committee had been agreed at £1,500. It was considered likely that funding from the Huddersfield District Committee would again be unsuccessful. Members discussed the request from Shelley Over 60's to combine their hanging basket order with the Council's to obtain a

lower unit cost.

**Recommendation**: To provide hanging baskets as last year, including those for Shelley Over 60's and any community group funding their own order.

**Recommendation**: To order hanging baskets from Premier 1, with the Clerk negotiating the best price available.
