Members considered the community project grant application from Kirkheaton Scouts & Guides for £1,619 towards the costs of hosting the annual village gala.

Recommendation: That the application is refused on the grounds that a) it appeared to be overly expensive and could be organised on a cheaper basis, b) the application did not include any estimates for income, c) there was no evidence supplied on the benefit the event provides to the community, d) there was no indication of the added value for the Scouts & Guides.

Cllr Brook left the meeting.

Members considered the community project grant application from Yetton Together (Facilities) for £2,232 towards the renewal of the hall and small front room flooring to make the rooms more financially viable and bring them up to an acceptable standard. Copies of additional quotes were distributed, which meant the special circumstances outlined in the application no longer applied.
