 - b) **Repair to the Boundary Wall:** To open the returned tenders to repair the section of the wall along Church Lane and to request professional advice from Lucas Lee, as agreed by Council.
 - c) **Work on Tree T29:** To consider the returned quotes for the work and make a recommendation to Council on which contractor to appoint.
