## Minutes of the Meeting on 11 November 2021 held at Burton Village Hall.

#### Min CG21 Apologies and Declarations of Interest

Apologies were received from Cllrs A Cooper. Cllr C Myles was absent.

The following declarations of interest were made:

Cllr Armer declared interests in the groups in Grange Moor, Shepley and Stocksmoor, as he knows the people involved.

Cllr Brook declared interests in Yetton Together, Kirkheaton Knitting Group and Kirkheaton Senior Citizens, as she knows the members.

Cllr Cowan declared interests in Shepley Magazine, Shepley Library Supporters, Friends of Cliffe House, Shepley Bowling Club, Shepley Croquet Club and Shepley Spring Festival, as he either holds a committee place or knows people within those organisations. He left the room whilst their small annual grant applications were considered.

Cllr Cunnington declared an interest in Grange Moor Community Association, as he attends the meetings.

Cllr Knight declared interests in Kirkburton AFC Seniors, as his son is a member and in Kirkheaton Environment Trust, as he is a member.

#### Min CG26 Kirkburton Senior Citizens Support Group

Members considered the application for £750 towards the cost of the Annual Tea and the Christmas Lunch. Total Project Cost: £1,200.

# Min CG27 Kirkheaton Cricket & Bowling Club
